A little about us

Our allotments are on land that has been in continual horticultural use since Anglo-Saxon times. In 1907 The Seven Kings and Goodmayes Horticultural Association managed the site until the late 1920s when the current Society was formed. We are very proud of the heritage of our allotment site and invite you to visit us.

How to find us

The entrance to the allotment site is adjacent to Poole's Court flats, the large red-brick building near Goodmayes library, opposite Budoch Drive. The site is about 10 minutes' walk from Goodmayes rail station, where trains from both directions stop every 20 minutes on Sundays. Bus 387 (Little Heath to Barking Reach) serves Goodmayes Lane, running every 20 minutes on Sundays. Local street parking is available for visitors arriving by car.
